**POPPIES OVER  
TEMORA**



ON REMEMBRANCE DAY, 2018, the  
Aviation Museum's Lockheed Hudson  
Bomber will drop 6,500 poppies over the  
Cenotaph as part of the Remembrance Day  
Service.

This incredible tribute is to  
commemorate the lives of all our fallen  
soldiers, from WWI right through to our  
current deployments. This will be the first  
time such a tribute will take place in  
Australia and has been more than 12  
months in the planning.

The Temora Branch of the R.S.L.  
cordially invites all residents to join them  
for the Service at the Cenotaph to mark  
the 100 year anniversary of Remembrance  
Day. As is tradition, the service will be  
held on the 11th hour of the 11th month –  
11am on November 11th, 2018. Please  
congregate at 10.45am.

November 11, 2018, marks the 100th

anniversary of the end of WWI. The  
number of deaths and casualties during the  
First World War remain the highest in  
Australian war history.

At the time, Australia's population was  
less than five million and more than 60,000  
troops were killed and a further 156,000  
were wounded, gassed, or taken prisoner.

The remembrance poppy now associated  
with Remembrance Day, was inspired by  
the poem "In Flanders Fields". Its opening  
lines refer to the many poppies that were  
the first flowers to grow in the churned-up  
earth of soldier's graves in Flanders, a  
region of Belgium.

November 11, 1918 was the armistice  
that ended the fighting on land, sea and in  
the air, which was finally made official by  
the signing of the Treaty of Versailles on  
28th June, 1919.

SUE EBERT is settling into her role as the Registrar Chamber Magistrate at Temora Courthouse, but there's more to her role than dealing with court proceedings.

There are several services on offer at the Courthouse and many of them will save you time and angst that you may experience when trying to sort matters of your own accord.

Ms Ebert can assist you with:

- Small neighbourly disputes
- Enquiries about court proceedings
- Local and criminal matters (such as debts)
- Civil debt mediation
- Chamber Magistrate Services such as civil claims and AVOs
- General enquiries including assistance with managing billing disputes, claim forms and other paperwork

- Referral to the Community Justice Centre (CJC) for matters that require further mediation
- Referrals to legal services such as Legal Aid.

Ms Ebert is also a registered Justice of the Peace (JP) and a celebrant. She is available to perform marriage and commitment services, naming ceremonies, and other officiations.

Temora Courthouse is currently open Monday to Thursday, 9.30am to 4pm, and no appointment is necessary for initial enquiries. Ms Ebert says "walk-ins are most welcome".



## CASTING CALL

TEMORA Medical Complex and Temora Shire Council have exciting forces in the search for a GP to call Temora home, and they aren't doing it quietly.

## NOV Australian 10-17 Food Safety 2018 Week

5 Simple tips to avoid becoming one of the 4.1 million cases of food poisoning each year



### CLEAN

Wash hands with soap and running water before handling food, wash the dishes regularly and keep the kitchen clean



### CHILL

Keep the fridge at 5°C or below, refrigerate any leftovers as soon as they've stopped steaming and use or freeze them within 3 days



### COOK

Cook poultry or minced products to 75°C in the centre, be aware of the risk of raw or minimally cooked egg dishes



### SEPARATE

Prevent cross contamination especially between raw meat or poultry and other foods that won't be cooked like salads



### DON'T COOK FOR OTHERS IF YOU HAVE GASTRO

You could make them sick too - so ask someone else to cook or get a takeaway
