

## HOME GROWN HEROES

Temora Shire Council have released a new project where we sit down with some of Temora's past and present residents who have a story to tell, can share outstanding achievements, have represented Temora in any capacity and proudly wave the Temora flag.

The first video interview was released in September, on Facebook, and has been viewed over 12,000 times. This video featured Dr Brett Fritsch, Orthopaedic Surgeon and Knee Specialist, who was kind enough to take time out of his very busy schedule to sit down with us and discuss his work, family and his roots. "We've had such a great response from the first video

that we have forged ahead and already recorded another 7 interviews, with plans for many more" a spokesperson from Council said.

The second video interview featuring teacher and Vietnam Veteran, Daryl Williams, was released in October and included a "bonus feature" as a follow up. In his interview, Daryl was very candid about his time in the army after being called to compulsory National Service whilst studying at University, sent to Kapooka for training and then deployment to Vietnam. "It's so important to hear these stories" the spokesperson said, "not just our veterans and senior citizens, but

all those people who contribute to our community and make up the core values Temora is so well known for. We are a proud town, and we are proud of our resident's achievements and stories. We are thrilled we can share them in this way." The video interviews, filmed by Unity Productions, are available for public view on the Temora Shire Facebook page or the Temora Shire YouTube Channel.

You can catch the Bald Archy Exhibition at the Bundawarra Centre from November 17 to December 10th daily from 10am – 4pm for a gold coin donation.


## You Be the Judge


- ~ Oil/Acrylic Painting (Thick Medium)
