Local Bush Fire Danger Period to Start

1st October 2015

BLAND TEMORA ZONE

In consultation with the Group Captains, Captains and Bush Fire Management Committee, the Local Bush Fire Danger period will begin on the 1st of October 2015.

Permits will be required for fires in the Local Government Areas of Bland and Temora Shires.

Permits can be obtained from your local Rural Fire Brigade or your local Fire Control Centre.

Permits will be suspended during

- **Days of Very High Fire Danger Ratings or Higher**
- **During Total Fire Bands**

Permit holders are required to contact 6972 0038 as conditions improve before the lighting of any fires.

Landholders are reminded that under the Rural Fires Act, they are required to take all precautionary measures to ensure fire does not escape their property.
