



## TEMORA ART CENTRE - REDUCING SOCIAL ISOLATION

THANKS to funding from the Department of Communities and Justice, a 12 month program has begun at Temora Arts Centre aiming to reduce social isolation after Covid.

"This fun and exciting grant project will deliver 24 free creative workshops over 12 months in the new Temora Arts Centre at 119 Aurora Street," said Temora Arts Centre Manager, Amanda Gay. "The grant is designed to encourage residents and visitors to come

together at the new Centre and socialise through creative workshops after a gruelling two years of social isolation."

"The grant project will culminate in December with an exhibition opening providing an opportunity for all participants to enjoy a social event showcasing their creative outcomes."

"To date we've already run workshops in still life drawing, art and cyberspace, printmaking and 'Becoming a

Bohemian'," she said. **Future workshops will include:**

## Adult Migrant English Program

TEMORA TAFE will soon be a delivery point for the Adult Migrant English Program.

"We are calling for volunteers in the community who can help deliver this program," said TAFE Services Coordinator, Shontayne Ward. "Full, paid training will be provided by TAFE."

The Adult Migrant English Program will aim to provide free English lessons (for eligible people) and free childcare to

assist all adults to participate. "The course can be delivered as full-time, part-time, day or evening, or even Saturday classes if required," said Ms Ward.

"The courses cover all levels of need - from beginners to high intermediate and are designed to help people gain employment."

"We are holding a launch of the Adult Migrant English Program on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> April," said Ms Ward. "All interested residents are invited to attend the launch at the TAFE at 9am," she said.

## Grow Program Update

THE consultation phase of the GROW program has now come to an end and a report is being prepared by GROW Local Facilitator, Roy Soliman.

The consultation consisted of several workshops as well as one on one interviews with people across the region with people from diverse backgrounds and relevant organisations.

The report will look at 18 different domains across the community to assess our readiness to welcome newcomers to our Shire. These domains include health, education,

housing, employment, transport, and community cohesion.

The report will be submitted along with reports from three other communities in the Riverina to feed into a three-year Newcomer Attraction and Retention Strategy for the region.

## Youth Leadership Program Gets the Go Ahead

A NEW Youth Leadership Program will be launched this year thanks to a Youth Opportunities Grant worth over \$12,000.

"The successful grant application means we can launch our Youth Leadership Program which aims to encourage young people to be the next generation of aspirational leaders," said Youth Development Officer, Sheree Elwin.

The program will run in collaboration with Temora Shire Council and TBEG.

The Temora Youth Leadership Program will give participants the opportunity to understand, engage in and practice leadership. During the regular

workshops and site visits, participants will gain skills in the following areas:

- team building and collaboration
- leadership in action
- presentation skills and public speaking
- interpersonal skills and communication
- self-assessment and reflection
- understanding my community
- understanding social responsibility.

"The program will demonstrate to our young people their ability to genuinely participate in the local community, enhancing their perception of how they are able to contribute to the future of Temora," said Ms Elwin.

The skills gained during the

program will provide the young people with the confidence to become young leaders in our community. The connections established with local organisations and mentors during the program will ensure they have the support and guidance required to actively participate in the community. The participants will also become ambassadors for the community and for the program itself, encouraging their peers to become more engaged in community activities.

"Development of the Leadership Program came from consultation with students from Temora High School after attending a REROC Youth Take Charge forum in Wagga.

Feedback from the young people indicated that leadership programs are of great benefit and identified a lack of leadership opportunities and programs within our community," said Ms Elwin.

The program will culminate in a graduation dinner with an inspirational guest speaker. There will be a presentation of certificates and commemorative photograph with participants giving a personal reflection of their experience in the program.

## Destination Inspiration

THE Destination Inspiration Events and Mentoring Program, supported by the Commonwealth Government's Building Better Regions Fund, aim to advance the projects and ideas of its participants.

The objectives of the program are:

- To motivate and inspire the development of new tourism businesses or the enhancement of existing tourism businesses.
- To educate and inform participants about what consumers expect from a visitor experience and what is considered best practice.
- For people to leave the event thinking 'I've got a great idea. If they can do it, I can too. I'm going to take the next step'.
- To provide participants with resources and support to make it happen.
- To increase the amount of high quality/hero tourism businesses and experiences in the Riverina Murray region.

The event is anchored by a panel of tourism operators (local and national) who have done exceptional things in the tourism space. People who have developed a tourism business

from the ground up, who have experienced challenges and setbacks along the way but who are now thriving. These operators will share their stories and deliver their key insights, lessons and learnings in order to inspire the participants to create their own tourism business.

Participants at the Destination Inspiration event series who want to advance their ideas will be invited to express their interest in participating in the one-on-one mentoring program. Each round of the 6-month program will have spaces for up to 15 participants and is designed to accelerate the product development process and progress ideas into new or enhanced experiences for visitors to the region. The Mentor's job is to help businesses get their new experience to market, quickly.



Running from Monday 4th April to Thursday 14th April, Youth Week is about celebrating the important contribution young people make to our communities and embracing them as our future leaders.

"This year's Youth Week program is filled with a diverse range of free activities and workshops," said Youth Development Officer, Sheree Elwin.

"Young people can do anything from boxing to baking, circus skills to first aid, and it's all free."

The Flying Fruit Fly Circus will be teaching things like juggling, diablo, plate spinning and hula hooping. Sugar & Spice's Dilini will be sharing her famous baking and decorating skills whilst personal trainer, Jo Cochrane will get the young people moving with some boxing skills.

"In addition, we have the Museum of Contemporary Art (MCA) running a four-day workshop which will guide young people through a series of activities that encourage play, experimentation, reflection, and expression," said Ms Elwin.

"Participants will learn about and unpack examples of contemporary art from the MCA's collection and use simple art materials and everyday objects to

practice different mediums and methods of creation," she said.

The MCA program is open to young people aged 12-20. Assistance with transport is available for those in outlying villages.

After Youth Week, for the remainder of the school holidays, Youth Program Coordinator Kassi Owen has some exciting holiday activities for young people.

"We have our DIY Body Products workshop at both Aria Park and Temora, a Resume Writing Workshop and 'Let's Get Crafty' to round out the holidays," said Miss Owen.


