Animals

- 1. IF STRAYING STOCK IS ON A PUBLIC ROADS
- 2. IF A DANGEROUS DOG IS 'AT LARGE'
- 3. IF THERE HAS BEEN A DOG ATTACK

Public Health

- 1. SYRINGE DISPOSAL IS A RISK
- 2. TRAFFIC RELATED INCIDENTS SUCH AS:
 - A. FLOODING / WATER OVER ROADS
 - B.FIRE CAUSING IMPACT TO ROADS
 - C.CAR ACCIDENTS CAUSING IMPACT TO ROADS
 - D.STORM DAMAGE (I.E. TREES & DEBRIS) CAUSING IMPACT TO ROADS
 - E.COUNCIL WORKSITE ISSUE (E.G. TRAFFIC OR SIGNAGE ISSUE)
- 3. SEWER SERVICE INTERRUPTION TO BE INSPECTED

Council facilities

- 1. ACCESS TO A COUNCIL FACILITIY ISN'T AS PER HIRING AGREEMENT (I.E. EVENTS, SPORTING EVENTS)
- 2. ISSUES IDENTIFIED AT COUNCIL FACILITIES OR ON COUNCIL PROPERTY (E.G. VANDALISM, DAMAGE, ETC.)
