Exciting New Transport Improvements Coming in 2026!

BASED on passenger feedback, NSW Trainlink is proposing improvements to better connect you to where you need to go, when you need to go. With new days and times of services, new stops, and new and improved routes.

The Griffith to Cootamundra route (formerly part of Mildura to Cootamundra) has revised timings and days of operation to additional services to enhance provide a more seamless rail connection at Cootamundra, saving Temora and Griffith passengers two hours on their journeys to and from Sydney and Canberra.

These proposed changes are expected to come into effect in 2026

Further to the Griffith/Temora to Cootamundra service improvements, NSW Translink




