Temora Shire's Economic Growth Gains Momentum

17 September 2025

Temora Shire Council is setting a clear direction for future growth with the creation of a new Economic Development and Investment Attraction Strategy — a key priority under the Community Strategic Plan 2025–2035.

The strategy, being developed by Pytheas Consulting, will identify high-value growth opportunities, support business retention and expansion, and align Temora Shire's local strengths with national and regional trends. It will also guide Council's efforts to attract new investment, foster innovation, and create jobs across the Shire.

"This strategy is about unlocking Temora Shire's potential," said Mayor Rick Firman. "We're proud of our Shire's strong foundations in agriculture, aviation, and community spirit — and this plan will help us build on those strengths in a way that's sustainable, , and future-focused."

Stakeholder workshops are scheduled for the 29 and 30 September, and Council is inviting local businesses, community groups, and residents to take part. The draft strategy will be presented in November, with public exhibition to follow.

The strategy comes at a time when Temora Shire is already seeing signs of positive growth, several large investments underway, including the expansion of the Jindalee Feedlot, construction of a third free range egg facility for LPC Eggs, and the \$95M Temora District Hospital Redevelopment. Coupled with Council's investment in community facilities over the past decade and a strong pipeline of residential subdivisions, Temora Shire is well-positioned to grow.

"Councillors and staff welcome investment that supports local jobs and services, and we're committed to ensuring that development is both responsible and respectful of our Shire's community concerns," said Mayor Firman.
