<p>Major Works planned by utility service providers that involve impacts upon:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Stormwater management</li> <li>○ Traffic generation</li> <li>○ Sewerage systems</li> <li>○ Water supply</li> <li>○ Installation of a temporary structure</li> <li>○ Enclosure of public place</li> <li>○ Excavation of a road or footpath</li> </ul>	<p>Notification must detail:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ the location of the proposed works,</li> <li>○ their expected duration and</li> <li>○ the nature of the planned interruption to Council's infrastructure (part or full road, footpath, nature strip or road verge closure, works involved),</li> <li>○ impact upon Council infrastructure (such as excavation),</li> <li>○ traffic management plans,</li> <li>○ inspections of work stages and</li> <li>○ completion of the project with final inspection.</li> </ul>	<p>Use notification form and submit three weeks prior to the planned works</p> <p><b>Relevant Council officers shall be informed by phone or email that works have commenced</b></p> <p><b>Companies are required to make good the road and nature strip/road verge following maintenance work.</b></p> <p><b>Works standards for reinstatement are set by Council.</b></p> <p><b>Utility companies must warrant the quality of their works for 12 months following completion of their works projects.</b></p>
<b>Roads Act</b>		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Erect a structure or carry out work in, on or over a public road</li> <li>○ Dig up or disturb the surface of a public road</li> <li>○ Remove or interfere with a structure, work or tree on a public road</li> <li>○ Pump water into a public road from any land adjoining the road</li> <li>○ Connect a road (whether public or private) to a classified road</li> </ul>	<p>Requires Council (or Roads and Maritime Service) permission</p>	<p>Use notification form</p>
<b>Nature Strips</b>		
<p>Driveways and gutter crossings</p>	<p>Requires Council permission</p>	<p>Driveway construction costs are the responsibility of the property owner.</p>
<p>Gutter bridges/ramps</p>	<p>Requires Council permission</p>	<p>Installations to provide access from a road to a residential</p>

		property must be constructed by approved Council contractors
Building works	Requires Council permission	Protect street tree/s and grassed nature strip during construction. Any barriers to be installed during construction require approval from Council prior to works commencing.
Irrigation	Requires Council permission	Installation of any pop up sprinkler irrigation systems within the nature strip requires the approval of Council. Pop up sprinkler systems may be inspected by Council
<b>Road Verges</b>		
Rural Access	Requires Council permission	It is the responsibility of the owner of the rural property to arrange the provision of access to a rural property
Native vegetation	Requires Council permission	Planting of native vegetation is permitted with the approval of Council Application must advise of the species, location and quantity of proposed planting
